Recommendation: That the Board:

1. Accept a donation to Fire Station 10, valued at \$7500 for the items listed below, and;
2. Instruct the Commission Executive Assistant II to forward this report for necessary action to the Mayor's Office in accordance with Executive Directive No. 3 and the City Council in accordance with the Los Angeles Administrative Code Article 12.

Summary.

Approximately one year ago, Fire Station 10 received a cash donation from Mr. Steve Needleman under the Adopt-a-Fire Station Program. The money was deposited into the California Community Foundation (CCF), who at the time was administering the Adopt-a-Fire Station Program for the Fire Department. However, at approximately the same time, the CCF made a decision to discontinue administration of the LAFD's Adopt-a-Fire Station Program. Due to our inability to access this money, Mr. Needleman has transferred his donation from the CCF to another charity.

Mr. Needleman is now interested in providing a variety of "In-Kind Gifts" with a cash value equivalent to his previous cash donation of \$7500. Following is the list of items being requested by Fire Station 10 and attached are the specifications for these items:

1. Stairmaster - \$2,100
2. Elliptical Exercise Machine - \$3,050
3. Outdoor BBQ - \$750
4. 2 - LCD Computer monitors for Front Office - \$370
5. 2 - Wireless Keyboards/mouse for Front Office - \$65
6. Wireless Router for House Dues Internet Access (for Lap Tops) - \$180
7. Blu-ray DVD Player for Training Room - \$135
8. 14 - Memory Foam Mattress Pads - \$850

ESTIMATED VALUE OF THESE ITEMS IS **\$7,500**

Fiscal Impact:

There is no fiscal impact to the City since none of these items will be serviced or maintained by the Department.

Conclusion:

The Fire Department is very fortunate to be the recipient of this type of generosity from Mr. Steve Needleman. The members of Fire Station 10 would like to acknowledge Mr. Needleman for his generous donation.
