SUMMARY

The Crenshaw Christian Center (home of the Faith Dome) has been a long-time supporter of all six fire stations in Battalion 13. Their generous contributions in the past have included holiday meals, equipment and station supplies. This Office has recently received a new request by church administrators to receive a freezer/ refrigerator, microwave and a cast Iron Skillet for Fire Station 57.

Battalion 13 has notified church administrators a request to receive the donated items will be submitted and when and if the request is approved, they will be notified. This request is being submitted for approval consistent with the Department policy delineated in a special notice dated December 4, 2007.

FINDINGS
