Recommendation: That the Board:

1. Accept a donation from the Valley Glen Neighborhood Association of various landscaping supplies for the members of Fire Station 102 in Battalion 14.

Summary: The Valley Glen Neighborhood Association sponsored a pancake breakfast and has generously given proceeds from this event to the Los Angeles Fire Department for the purchase of landscaping supplies going towards the upgrading and beautification of Fire Station 102. The Valley Glen Neighborhood Association will pay for supplies directly to vendors, valued at \$1260, and Fire Station 102 members will perform all labor. Pursuant to the Los Angeles Administrative Code, Article 12, Section 5.111.4(a), "Receipt of Gifts and Bequests of Personal Property by the Fire Department," provides the authority to the Fire Commission to accept or reject bequests of personal property not exceeding \$5,000 in market value

Fiscal Impact: There is no fiscal impact to the Department's budget in the acceptance of this donation.

Conclusion: The Los Angeles Fire Department benefits tremendously from gracious donations such as that received from the Valley Glen Neighborhood Association. This support provides the Fire Department with resources to continue its programs and activities that have a benefit to the community.
