#### Recommendations:

The following recommendations are submitted to the Board for consideration and public hearing. In accordance with Section 57.04.12, Subsection C of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (L.A.M.C.), which authorizes the Board to modify fees based on the cost of services, these recommendations have been reviewed and concurred by the City Administrative Officer. It is recommended that:

- 1. The Inspector Hourly Rate be increased from \$156 per hour to \$160 per hour (approximately 3 percent). The Inspector Hourly Rate is applicable to fees charged in the following activities:
  - Continuing Permits Activities (L.A.M.C., Section 57.04.12C)
  - Non-Continuing Permit Activities and Emergency Inspections (L.A.M.C., Sections 57.05.31 and 57.05.32)
  - Miscellaneous Fees (L.A.M.C., Sections 57.01.28, 57.01.30, 57.05.14, 57.05.15, and 57.06.15)
  - Construction and Plan Review Inspection Services (L.A.M.C., Section 57.15)
- 2. The fees for Continuing Permits Activities be modified to include additional fee categories as follows:
  - Assemblage Occupancy category be modified from 1 to 10 fee categories.
  - Day Care Occupancy category be modified from 1 to 4 fee categories.
  - Hospital category to include 2 fee categories.
  - Schools category be modified from 4 to 11 fee categories.
  - Surgical Center category be charged at a fee of 2 hours.

- Theater category be modified from 2.5 hours to 3 hours.
- Motion Picture Theater category be modified from 1 to 2 fee categories.

3. The Brush Initial Inspection Fee (L.A.M.C., Section 57.21.07B) be increased from \$13 to \$23 (approximately 77 percent).

- 4. The Brush Administrative Cost Fee (L.A.M.C., Section 57.21) be decreased from \$1,112 to \$997 (approximately 10 percent).
- 5. The High-Rise Building Annual Inspection and Permit Fee (L.A.M.C., Section 57.119) be modified as follows:
  - The building inspection rate to remain at \$0.0141 per square foot.
  - The garage inspection rate to remain at \$0.0071 per square foot.
  - The base building fee be increased from \$936 to \$960 (approximately 3 percent). The base building fee is aligned to the Inspector Hourly Rate).
- The Final Clearance Inspection Fee for residential care facilities for the elderly (L.A.M.C., Section 57.113.16B) be charged at 2 hours of the Inspector Hourly Rate or \$320.
- 7. The Board's Executive Assistant be directed to publish the required notice of public hearing on the proposed fee increase at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board.
- 8. The attached Resolution (<u>Attachment H</u>) adjusting the Board controlled fees be adopted after the required public hearing, and notice of this action be transmitted to the Mayor and City Council at the conclusion of the public hearing. If the Mayor and Council do not take action within 60 days, the Resolution adopted by the Board will be published through the Office of the Board of Fire Commissioners and the new fees will become effective upon publication.
- 9. The Board's Executive Assistant be directed to publish the Resolution based on Mayor and City Council action.

#### Summary:

The Bureau of Fire Prevention and Public Safety fees for the cost of special services are reviewed annually. Based on the costs and the estimated number of hours required in an inspection, the following recommendations are made.

The Inspector Hourly Rate be increased from \$156 to \$160. The Inspector Hourly Rate is applicable to the Continuing Permits, Non-Continuing Permits, Sections 57.01.28, 57.01.30, 57.05.14, 57.05.15, and 57.06.15 of the L.A.M.C., Construction and Plan Review Inspection Services, and the high-rise base building fee.

Additional fee categories be added to the Continuing Permit Activities to provide for a more equitable fee structure based on estimated hours required for an inspection, and / or to add clarity to the definition of a category or occupancy / usage type.

The Brush Inspection Fee be increased from \$13 to \$23. The Brush Inspection Fee has not been adjusted since 1998.

The Brush Administrative Cost Fee be adjusted from \$1,112 to \$997. The Brush Administrative Cost Fee is determined by the cost of the brush clearance program divided by the average number of pre-packaged inspections or violators.

The Brush Administrative Cost Fee and the number of violators are inversely related. As the number of violators increases, the cost of the to brush clearance program is distributed over a larger number of violators, thus decreasing the Brush Administrative Cost Fee paid by each violator.

The Final Clearance Inspection Fee for residential care facilities for the elderly be charged 2 hours of the Inspector Hourly Rate or \$320. The Department had previously not charged for these services but based on the service hours being expended to conduct these inspections, it is recommended that 2 hours per inspection be charged to recover the cost of the service.

#### Findings:

The Bureau of Fire Prevention and Public Safety fees for the cost of special services are determined based on direct and indirect staff costs and expenses to perform these special services. The fees are computed based on the Inspector Hourly Rate multiplied by the average time required to perform the inspection. The average time required to perform an inspection activity is based on historical data of staff hours spent on specific related activities. These hours are reviewed and adjusted annually.

The Inspector Hourly Rate is the average hourly cost of an Inspector in the Bureau of Fire Prevention and Public Safety including all direct and indirect costs. The Inspector Hourly Rate is determined using the proposed Fiscal Year 2010 - 2011 salaries and the federally audited and approved Cost Allocation Plan (CAP) 31 Rate. The approved CAP 31 Rate for sworn fire personnel increased from 91.9 percent to 99.6 percent and for civilian personnel increased from 87.77 percent to 87.98 percent. Based on the proposed Fiscal Year 2010 - 2011 salaries and the approved CAP 31 Rate, the Inspector Hourly Rate was determined to be \$160 per hour. In order to be consistent with the City's financial policy of full cost recovery, it is proposed that the Inspector Hourly Rate be increased from \$156 per hour to \$160 per hour (approximately 3 percent increase).

The following Sections of the L.A.M.C. pertain to the recommended increase in fees:

1. Continuing Permit Activities – L.A.M.C., Section 57.04.12 – Permit Processing and Annual Permit Inspection.

Division 4 of the Fire Code identifies certain occupancies and operations, which require an annual continuing permit issued by the City. Because of variations in the number of hours required to perform these inspections, it is proposed that additional fee categories be added to provide for a more equitable fee structure based on the number of hours required for inspection.

The table below identifies the modified fee categories, the conditions for which they apply, and the number of inspection hours proposed. Upon final approval of the report by Mayor and City Council, new Code numbers will be assigned to the additional fee categories by the Office of Finance.

In the table above, "Assemblage Occupancy" was modified from 1 to 10 fee categories based on occupancy type/usage and/or number of occupants.

"Adult Day Care" was added to "Community Care Facility" to better define and add clarity to the occupancy type.

"Day Care Occupancy" was modified from 1 to 4 fee categories based on number of occupants or occupancy type.

"Hospital" was added to the Office of Finance Division 4 - Continuing Permits list. It is already included under L.A.M.C., Section 57.04.12 but had inadvertently been left out of the Office of Finance Division 4 - Continuing Permits list. An additional category "Hospital / Nursing Home" was added to differentiate a nursing home from a hospital.

An "Oil Well producing 15 years prior to 1/1/1960 (Code 360)" was removed from the list and consolidated into the "Oil Well (Code 358)" category. Both Code 360 and Code 358 oil well categories were charging 5 inspection hours.

"Schools" was modified from 4 to 11 fee categories based on the number of occupants.

"Surgical Center" was added to the Office of Finance Division 4 - Continuing Permits list. It is already included under L.A.M.C., Section 57.04.12 but had inadvertently been left out of the Office of Finance Division 4 - Continuing Permits list.

The hours for "Theater" were increased from 2.5 hours to 3 hours.

"Motion Picture Theatre" was modified from 1 to 2 fee categories based on the number of screens in the theater.

The complete list of recommended Division 4 fees is shown in Attachment A.

2. Non-Continuing Permit Activities – L.A.M.C., Sections 57.05.31 and 57.05.32.

Division 5 of the Fire Code identifies certain installations or operations of a one-time or non-continuing nature, which require plan checks and/or inspections. These permits are issued for a wide variety of activities, including firework displays, live theater productions, and the transfer of flammable liquids.

The recommended fees for Division 5 activities are detailed in Attachment B.

3. Miscellaneous Divisions 1, 5, and 6 Activities (L.A.M.C., Sections 57.01.28, 57.01.30, 57.05.14, 57.05.15, and 57.06.15).

A number of miscellaneous activities within Divisions 1, 5, and 6 of the Fire Code are under the Board's fee-setting authority. These include General Approvals sought by manufacturers of specified items, fees for conducting tests to certify non-specified items, variance and waivers from provisions of the Fire Code; and Certificates of Fitness issued to individuals engaged in the recharging of fire extinguishers, in conducting blasting operations, or certifying the installation of fire protection equipment. The recommended fees are detailed in Attachment C.

4. Construction and Plan Review Inspection Services (L.A.M.C., Section 57.15).

Division 15 of the Fire Code provides Fire/Life Safety plan review and inspection services of new construction, additions, tenant improvements, and/or change of use construction projects within the City. The recommended Division 15 fees are detailed in <a href="https://example.com/Attachment">Attachment D</a>.

The Expedite or Off-Hour Fee is charged when a customer requests the Fire Department staff to expedite or perform plan review or inspection services outside of normal working hours. The Expedite or Off-Hour Fee is an overtime rate calculated based on the weighted average cost of Fiscal Year 2010 - 2011 staff salaries multiplied by 1.5 times or an hourly overtime rate of \$86 per hour. The Expedite or Off-Hour Fee is charged at a minimum of 4 hours, or \$344 and \$86 per hour thereafter. The Expedite or Off-Hour Fee is charged in addition to any regular fees.

5. Hazardous Vegetation (L.A.M.C., Section 57.21.07)

#### The Brush Initial Inspection Fee

The Brush Initial Inspection Fee provides for the cost of yearly inspecting approximately 131,000 parcels in the Very High Fire Hazard Severity zone. The inspection cost is divided amongst the 131,000 parcels.

Those parcels found not in compliance with the hazardous vegetation ordinance are issued an order to correct and subsequently re-inspected. If after the third inspection, the property is still in violation, the property is packaged and bid out for clearance by a brush clearance contractor.

#### The Brush Administrative Cost Fee

The Brush Administrative Cost Fee covers for the cost of the staff to perform the brush re-inspections and processing of the bid packages/contracts for award to a contractor. The Brush Administrative Cost Fee is determined by taking the time required by the sworn and civilian staff to perform inspections and contract processing, divided by the average number of pre-packaged inspections. Direct and overhead costs are included in the cost calculation for full cost recovery.

The Brush Administrative Cost Fee is thus determined by taking the total cost to perform the services divided by the average number of pre-packaged inspections (violators). There is an inverse relationship between the Brush Administrative Cost Fee and the number of violators. An increase in the number of violators will divide the total cost over a larger number of violators and thus decrease the Brush Administrative Cost Fee paid by each violator.

Using the Fiscal Year 2010 - 2011 salaries and the approved CAP 31, a Brush Initial Inspection Fee of \$23, and a Brush Administrative Cost Fee of \$997 was determined.

It is proposed that the Brush Initial Inspection Fee be increased from \$13 to \$23 (approximately 77%) and the Brush Administrative Cost Fee be decreased from \$1,112 to \$997 (approximately 10 percent) to recover the costs of the Brush Clearance Program.

The Brush Clearance Program fees are detailed in Attachment E.

6. High-Rise Building Annual Inspection and Permit Fee (L.A.M.C., Section 57.119)

The High-Rise Building Annual Inspection Fees provide for the cost of the staff to perform inspections of all commercial and residential high-rise buildings. The High-Rise Annual Inspection Fees consist of a base building fee, a building inspection fee, and a garage inspection fee.

The base building fee is the minimum administrative fee for all high-rise buildings, including vacant and/or partially vacant buildings. The building inspection fee is calculated based on the total floor area of the building. The garage inspection fee is calculated based on the total floor area of the garage.

The total floor area of high-rise hotels, dormitories, apartments, and condominiums is assessed only on the common areas in the building.

Federal and State buildings are inspected yearly but are exempt from the fee.

Based on the Fiscal Year 2010 - 2011 salaries and the approved CAP 31, it is proposed that the High-Rise Annual Inspection Fees be modified as follows:

• The building inspection fee to remain at \$0.0141 per square foot.

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- The garage inspection fee to remain at \$0.0071 per square foot.
- The base building fee be increased from \$936 to \$960 (approximately 3 percent).

The High-Rise Annual Inspection Fees are detailed in Attachment F.

7. Final Clearance Inspection Fee (L.A.M.C., Section 57.113.16B)

A prospective state licensee of a residential care facility for the elderly may request for a fire clearance safety inspection in connection with issuance of a state license. The Inspectors in the Bureau of Fire Prevention and Public Safety currently conduct the inspection although no fee is currently charged. It is proposed that 2 hours of the Inspector Hourly Rate be charged for the final clearance inspection service to recover the cost of the service. The proposed fee for a final clearance inspection is 2 hours at the Inspector Hourly Rate, or \$320.

The Final Clearance Inspection Fee is detailed in Attachment G.

### Conclusion:

Increasing the Inspector Hourly Rate to be in alignment with costs and revenue is consistent with the City's financial policy of cost recovery for specialized services.
