**Recommendation:** That the Board:

1. Accept a donation from the California Community Foundation (CCF) for the members of Fire Station 17.

**Summary:** The CCF has donated a Lifecycle Exercise Bike to be used by all members at Fire Station 17 in the value of \$1050.00. Pursuant to the Los Angeles Administrative Code, Article 12, Section 5.111.4(a), "Receipt of Gifts and Bequests of Personal Property by the Fire Department," provides the authority to the Fire Commission to accept or reject bequests of personal property not exceeding \$5,000 in market value.
