Recommendation: That the Board:

1. Accept a donation from the California Community Foundation (CCF) for the members of Fire Station 105.

Summary: The CCF has donated a Commercial Grade Washing Machine Extractor that will be used by all members at Fire Station 105. This in-kind donation is in the value of \$2,512.91. Pursuant to the Los Angeles Administrative Code, Article 12, Section 5.111.4(a), "Receipt of Gifts and Bequests of Personal Property by the Fire Department," provides the authority to the Fire Commission to accept or reject bequests of personal property not exceeding \$5,000 in market value.

Fiscal Impact: There is no fiscal impact to the Department's budget in the acceptance of this donation. Members of Fire Station 105 shall be responsible to maintain, repair and or replace this donated item.

The members at Fire Station 105 have agreed to purchase a **Commercial Washing Machine / Extractor** utilizing Adopt-A-Fire Station funds. This Item will be purchased from **COIN METER PACIFIC – a Division of Coin Meter Washer Service Inc., 16709 Gramercy Pl. Gardena, CA. 90247, Telephone # (310) 217-0196.** This item, including a base, will cost ~~\$3073.00.~~ **\$2512.91**

This Commercial Washing Machine / Extractor is the same type and model purchased by the L.A. City Fire Department "Purchasing and Supplies Section" for the washing of member's Personal Protective Equipment. The Vendor is an approved vendor used by the LAFD. We are requesting the purchase of this machine with AAFS funds in order that the members assigned to Fire Station 105 will have the ability to routinely wash their Personal Protective Equipment without having to travel to a remote location to do so.

An invoice is attached reflecting the total purchase price. Any amount not covered by the amount of AAFS funds available to Fire Station 105 in this purchase will be paid by Fire Station 105 "House Dues" funds. The members assigned to Fire Station 105 have approved this as well. In addition, a W-9 form from the listed Vendor is attached.
