<u>Summary</u>: The Foundation has donated 22 Honor Guard uniforms and accessories to be used by the members of the Honor Guard Cadre in the value of \$4,858.21. Pursuant to the Los Angeles Administrative Code, Article 12, Section 5.111.4(a), "Receipt of Gifts and Bequests of Personal Property by the Fire Department," provides the authority to the Fire Commission to accept or reject bequests of personal property not exceeding \$5,000 in market value.

Fiscal Impact: There is no fiscal impact to the Department's budget in the acceptance of this donation. Members of the Honor Guard shall be responsible to maintain, repair and or replace these donated items.
