Recommendation: That the Board:

1. Accept a donation from the Encino Neighborhood Council (ENC) for the members of Fire Station 83.

Summary: The ENC has donated two (2) refurbished Startrac 4500 treadmills for the use of all members at Fire Station 83 with a combined value of \$2,410.25. Pursuant to the Los Angeles Administrative Code, Article 12, Section 5.111.4(a), "Receipt of Gifts and Bequests of Personal Property by the Fire Department," provides the authority to the Fire Commission to accept or reject bequests of personal property not exceeding \$5,000 in market value.

Fiscal Impact: There is no fiscal impact to the Department's budget in the acceptance of this donation. Members of Fire Station 83 shall be solely responsible to maintain, repair and or replace these donated items.

Conclusion: The Los Angeles Fire Department benefits tremendously from gracious donations such as that received from the ENC. The Community Liaison Office would like to acknowledge the ENC for their generous donation.

The treadmills being offered are refurbished Startrac 4500's worth a retail value of \$2410.25.




