Recommendation: That the Board:

- Accept a donation from the Arleta Neighborhood Council and an anonymous private donor for a Holmatro rescue tool (model # BCT 4120) with accessories and a Stihl Chain Saw (model # 460MS) with carrying case for the use of all members at Fire Station 7 during emergency incidents.
- 2. Instruct the Commission Executive Assistant to forward this report for necessary action to the Mayor's Office in accordance with Executive Directive No. 3 and the City Council in accordance with the Los Angeles Administrative Code Article 12.

<u>Summary</u>: The Arleta Neighborhood Council and an anonymous donor would like to donate the Holmatro Rescue Tool with accessories in the monetary value of \$10,500 and the Stihl Chain Saw with carrying case in the monetary value of \$1,200 for a total value of \$11,700.

Fiscal Impact: There is no fiscal impact to the Department's budget in the acceptance of this donation other than Tony Varela, Assistant Chief, Training and Support Bureau has verified that the Department will provide annual maintenance, replacement parts, and service as needed.

<u>Conclusion:</u> The Los Angeles Fire Department benefits tremendously from gracious donations such as that received from the Arleta Neighborhood Council and this anonymous private donor. This support provides the Fire Department with additional resources to better serve the community. Fire Station 7 is one of the Department's busiest stations and responds to a wide-array of incident types, many of which are traffic related. Due to the recent closure of LAFD resources, Engine Companies are now tasked with greater challenges, responsibilities, and must now anticipate greater operational responsibilities beyond traditional Engine Company Operations. The addition of the Holmatro tool will allow the members of Engine 7 to gain simple access to damaged vehicles without requesting additional resources, and if necessary initiate life saving techniques prior to the arrival of other dispatched resources on physical rescue incidents.

The addition of the Stihl Chainsaw will allow members on Engine 7 to carry out ventilation operations if assigned or support operations on brush fire incidents when needed.

It is respectfully requested that the battery powered Holmatro Rescue Tool and Stihl Chainsaw be accepted by the LAFD and added to the inventory of Engine 7. These tools could prove to be invaluable and will greatly assist us in providing better service to the community and the citizens of our area while increasing operational efficiency.
