RECOMMENDATIONS: That the Board:

1. Accept a donation from the Los Angeles Fire Department Foundation (Foundation) of 202 software licenses for Apple "iWorks" software suite to support the Interactive Learning Station (ILS) project.
2. Instruct the Commission Executive Assistant to forward this report for necessary action to City Council in accordance with the Los Angeles Administrative Code, Ordinance 155514, Article 12, Section 5.111.4(a).

SUMMARY:

The Foundation has donated 202 individual software licenses for Apple's "iWorks" software to be used as an integral part of the ILS project. The software provides tools to enhance the station learning environment by allowing members to develop presentations and then display and share that material with every computer in the ILS network. This donation is in the monetary value of \$6200.00. Once the software licenses are secured, they will be loaded onto each ILS computer. The purchase of this product represents a significant cost savings and is compatible on both Microsoft and Macintosh operating systems.

Apple is offering its iWorks® software suite to the Department at a government rate. This cost is 50 percent less than purchasing this product from Apple as a consumer and 75 percent less than the comparable "Microsoft® Office® for Mac" software. The iWorks® software suite is "Pages", "Numbers," and "Keynote." They are the equivalent of Microsoft's "Word" software package. Whether sent or received, iWorks can convert PDF, "Word" and "Power Point" and is compatible with Microsoft®.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact to the Department's budget from the acceptance of this donation. Every Department member will have access to and benefit from this software. The In Service Training Section and Management Information Systems will install, maintain and update this donated software.

CONCLUSION:

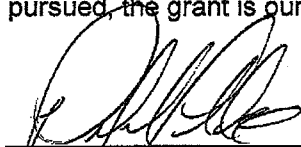
