RECOMMENDATION: That the Board:

- 1. Accept a donation from On Core Pro/Environments-Plus of one ice maker for use at the Supply and Maintenance Division.
- 2. Pursuant to the Los Angeles Administrative Code Ordinance 155514, Article 12, Section 5.111.4(a), "Receipt of Gifts and Bequests of Personal Property by the Fire Department," provides the authority to the Fire Commission to accept or reject beguests of personal property not exceeding \$5,000 in market value.

SUMMARY:

The On Core Pro/Environments-Plus would like to donate a slightly used ice maker to the Supply and Maintenance Division. This ice maker was no longer needed by the company or its clients, and it was offered to the Fire Department. The total amount of this donation is approximately \$2,000.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact to the Department's budget from the acceptance of this donation. The Supply and Maintenance Division will be responsible for any maintenance or repair of the donated item.

CONCLUSION:

The Los Angeles Fire Department benefits from gracious donations such as that received from On Core Pro-Environments-Plus. The Administrative Operations Bureau would like to acknowledge this generous donation from On Core Pro-Environments-Plus.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Fire Department accept into its inventory a donated icemaker.

FINDINGS

On April 17, 2012, Fire Facilities Section became the recipient of a Scotsman Touch-Free Ice Machine, model MDT4F12A-1H, Serial No. 09061320010355, donated by On Core Pro/Environments-Plus. The donor responsible for the donation is Tim Jones with On Core Pro. Mr. Jones stated that a client who had closed an office donated the ice machine to him; this appliance was located in the kitchen/break room and used by the employees. Mr. Jones was unable to use or store the unit and offered it to the Fire Department. Fire Facilities Section arranged for the Supply & Maintenance Division to receive the ice machine for its exclusive use.
