Recommendation: That the Board:

- 1. Accept the Visa gift card donation of \$5,000 (Attachment 1), which is part of a courtmandated Stipulated Sentencing Order, in lieu of a probation violation, to the Los Angeles Fire Department's Legal Liaison Unit by property owner, Millenium Holdings (Attachment 2).
- 2. Approve the purchase of equipment for the Legal Liaison Unit (Attachment 3).

Summary: A Visa gift card was provided to the Los Angeles Fire Department's Legal Liaison Unit for its sole use for equipment in the amount of \$5,000, in lieu of a probation violation for Fire Code violations for the property located at 119 North Avenue 51, Los Angeles, California. by Defendant, Millenium Holdings.

The Legal Liaison Unit is working with the Los Angeles Fire Department's Management Information Systems Section (MISS) to procure City Standard equipment for Legal Liaison. Pursuant to the Los Angeles Administrative Code, Article 12, Section 5.111.4(a), "Receipt of Gifts and Bequests of Personal Property by the Fire Department," provides the authority to the Fire Commission to accept or reject bequests of personal property not exceeding \$5,000 in market value.

Fiscal Impact: There is no fiscal impact to the Los Angeles Fire Department's budget in the acceptance of this donation.

Conclusion: Upon your Board's approval, the Fire Prevention Bureau will proceed with procurement of the office equipment.

WAIVER OF RIGHTS

Defendant MILLENIUM HOLDINGS -understands the nature of the charges and the possible pleas and defenses. Defendant MILLENIUM HOLDINGS waives their right to a jury trial; their rights to confront and cross examine witnesses at trial; and, their right to present witnesses and evidence on their own behalf at trial. Defendant MILLENIUM HOLDINGS also waives their right to appeal, and to file any appeal, any collateral attack, or any other writ or motion arising from the judgment and sentence imposed pursuant to this agreement as to both form and substance.

Imposition of sentence is suspended, and the defendant is placed on summary probation for 48 months on the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The defendant shall bring and keep the buildings located 119 North Avenue 51, Los Angeles, California 90042 and 219 North Avenue 51, Los Angeles, California 90042 in the City of Los Angeles, into compliance with all relevant Housing, Fire, Building and County Health Codes, as well as relevant portions of the Rent Stabilization Ordinance.
- 2. Defendant shall not transfer ownership of the property unless and until it is brought into compliance, or unless permitted to do so by the court.

3. Defendant shall pay a fines as follows:

- a. <u>1HY05123:</u> Fine in the amount of \$500.00 plus penalty assessment. The fine shall be made to the **Clerk of the Superior Court**. Defendant shall provide proof of payment of the court fine plus penalty assessment and State surcharge as directed by the court.
- 4. Defendant shall pay to the court costs with applicable penalty assessment.
- 5. Defendant shall pay the court surcharge per count.
- 6. Defendant shall pay investigative costs in the amount of \$2,768.54 (two thousand seven hundred sixty eight dollars and fifty four cents) to Department of Health Services (DHS) said payments shall be in the form of cashier's check or money order made out to DHS. The payment shall be made by cashier's check or money order through the Los Angeles City Attorney's Office, Housing Enforcement Section.
- 7. Defendant shall pay investigative costs in the amount of \$ 3,122.00 (three thousand one hundred and twenty two dollars) to Los Angeles City Fire Department (LAFD) said payments shall be in the form of cashier's check or money order made out to LAFD. The payment shall be made by cashier's check or money order through the Los Angeles City Attorney's Office, Housing Enforcement Section.
- 8. Defendant shall provide a pre-paid Visa Card to the Los Angeles City Fire Department Legal Liaison Unit for its sole use for equipment and training in the amount of \$5,000.00 in lieu of a probation violation for the property located at 119 North Avenue 51, Los Angeles California.
- Defendant shall pay investigative costs to Los Angeles City Housing Department (LAHD) directly and provide proof of payment to the City Attorney's Office and to the Court.
- 10. Defendant shall donate one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) to any of the following charities at the discretion of Defendant:

- Habitat for Humanity of Greater Los Angeles, 17700 South Figueroa St. Gardena, California 90248; Telephone: (310) 323-4663; Fax: (310) 323-0789; and/or,
- The African American Firefighters Museum, 1401 South Central Ave., Los Angeles, California 90021 Telephone: (213) 744-1730, Fax: (213) 744-1731
- 3. The Boys and Girls Club of Los Angeles which functions in the area that the Defendant's properties are located.

Defendant is to deliver the payment to the agency and provide proof of payment to the Los Angeles City Attorney's Office and to the Court in the form of a receipt and a photocopy of the check made out to the agency.

- 11. The Defendant, is not to sell, transfer, or otherwise dispose of the Subject Property, or any of the properties owned, operated, or managed by the Defendant, without first having disclosed to any purchaser all outstanding Notices of Violations, Orders to Comply or any other Notice of violation from any State, County or municipal enforcement agency. Said notice it to be provided at the opening of any escrow for any properties. Defendant is to provide the City Attorney and the Court with copies of the notices provided before the close of escrow.
- 12. If the Defendant is issued a Notice of Violation, Order to Comply or any other Notice citing violations at any property other than the properties that are the subject of this stipulated agreement and sentencing; it is contemplated that the Defendant shall be afforded a reasonable opportunity to correct all violations within the compliance period set by the issuing agency. These agencies shall include, but not be limited to the Los Angeles Housing Department, the Los Angeles Department of Building and Safety, the Los Angeles Fire Department, the Los Angeles Housing Authority, and the Los Angeles County Department of Health Services. Notices of Violations or Orders to Comply shall

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be handled pursuant to the following procedure:

- 1. Upon receipt of a Notice of Violation or Order to Comply, Defendants' attorney of record shall acknowledge receipt of said Notice within 48 hours by sending a copy of said Notice to the Deputy City Attorney, Housing Enforcement Section. If the 48 hours falls on a weekend or a holiday, then the notice shall be sent the next business day. This acknowledgment shall cause the hereinafter time sensitive procedures to occur.
- 2. Defendants shall have the compliance time period, as ordered by the issuing agency, to satisfactorily complete necessary repairs. If the Defendants are unable to complete the repairs within the time period allowed by the issuing agency, defendant's attorney of record may request a case status conference with the Deputy City Attorney at the subject Property to meet, confer, and attempt to settle upon a compliance timeline.
- 3. If a timetable for compliance timeline cannot be agreed upon, the parties shall petition the court to decide the issue. The parties stipulate that the court will dictate when the corrective action shall be completed.
- 4. If the Defendants complete corrective action required by the issuing agency within the time provided in the Notice or Order. Defendant shall send proof of completion of corrective action to the inspector from the agency, Defendant's counsel and the Los Angeles City Attorney Housing Enforcement Section. Probation shall continue if the corrective measures are timely completed.
- 13. Upon sentencing, the People will move to dismiss all remaining counts and all charges against all remaining Defendants.


