SUMMARY

The First in Fire Foundation has purchased and donated a Trinity 41" stainless steel Tool Chest for Fire Station 61. This tool chest will be used to replace the existing one which is beyond repair. The combined monetary value of the tool chest is \$1,089.99. Pursuant to the Los Angeles Administrative Code, Article 12, Section 5.111.4(a), "Receipt of Gifts and Bequests of Personal Property by the Fire Department," provides the authority to the Fire Commission to accept or reject bequests of personal property not exceeding \$5,000 in market value.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Board:

1. Accept a donation from the First in Fire Foundation for the members of Fire Station 61.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact to the Department's budget in the acceptance of this donation. Members of Fire Station 61 shall be solely responsible to maintain, repair and/or replace these donated items.

SUBJECT: APPROVAL TO PURCHASE TOOL CHEST






