Fire Administrator June Gibson	The Budget and Finance Committee considered the CAO's mid-year report, which included a recommendation to terminate the ambulance augmentation plan for the remaining three months of the fiscal to reduce the Department's deficit by \$2.5 million. After Chief Rueda conveyed the plan's benefits to the public and to the Department, the Committee indicated it would not support the CAO recommendation. June reported to the Committee that the projected reimbursement from the Ground Emergency Medical Transport program will amount to \$24 million rather than \$18 million previously estimated.
