Are you working on a Los Angeles River project? Submit your organization's LA River project to receive feedback and evaluation by the [Los Angeles River Cooperation Committee \(LARCC\)](#).

The LARCC is a joint working group comprised of the Los Angeles County Flood Control District and the City of Los Angeles, in conjunction with the United States Army Corps of Engineers. The LARCC convenes quarterly to coordinate and evaluate projects along the upper reach of the Los Angeles River in a public forum to provide feedback and awareness to LA River projects.
