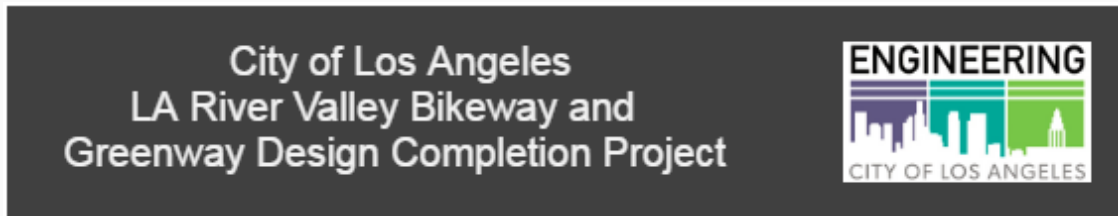


City of Los Angeles Bureau of Engineering LA River Bikeway and Greenway Design Completion Project - Community Meeting Invite

The City of Los Angeles Bureau of Engineering invites you to attend the second in a series of community meetings to discuss the LA River Valley Bikeway and Greenway Design Completion Project. During the first round of meetings, you had the opportunity to learn more about the project and provide input on preliminary design concepts. For this second round of meetings, you will have the opportunity to provide input and comment on selected project alignment alternatives and design concepts.

The LA River Valley Bikeway and Greenway Design Completion project, currently nearly complete with the pre-design phase, involves designing and constructing approximately 13 miles of new bike path and greenway facilities along the Los Angeles River that will complement and connect to projects that have already been built or are underway. The project area encompasses San Fernando Valley from Vanalden Avenue to Forest Lawn Drive/Zoo Drive.
