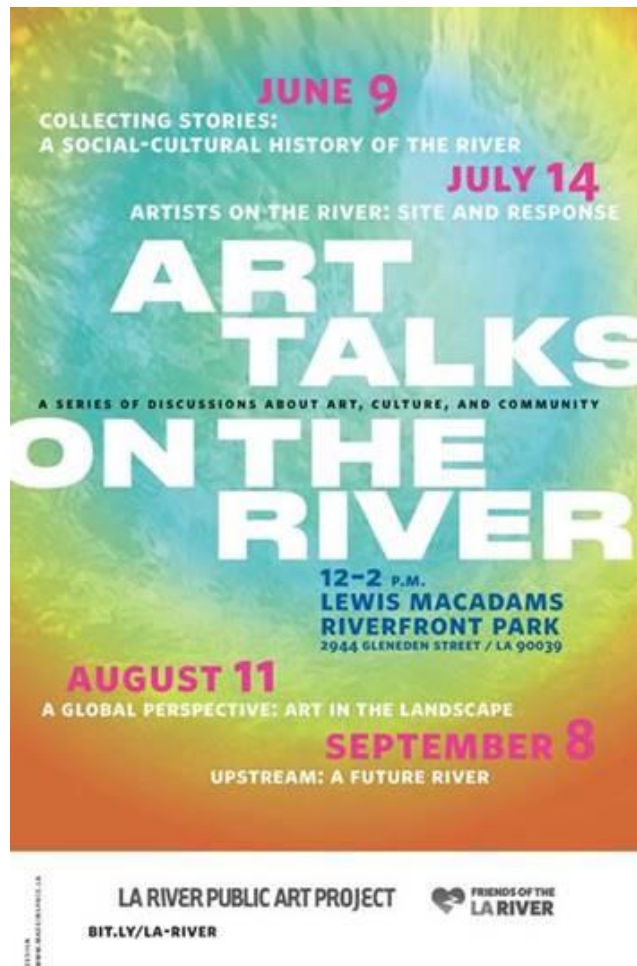


**Art Talks on the River presents

- Panelist **David Rosenboom** is the composer of Hopscotch. Directed by MacArthur Grant awardee Yuval Sharon, the opera was performed on the streets of LA – and the LA River.
- Panelist **Beatriz Cortez's** sculpture *Tzolk'in* is now on view at the Hammer's Made in LA Biennial, 2018, and on the River at the Bowtie.
