FIND that the City's *Skelly* due process provisions were met.

SUSTAIN the cause of action of using official position for personal gain or advantage.

SUSTAIN the cause of action of engaging in any activity, which constitutes a conflict of interest. SUSTAIN the cause of action of misusing or failing to use delegated authority in the performance of duties.

SUSTAIN the cause of action of failure to perform work assignments adequately or promptly.

FIND that the imposed penalty of a 45 working day unpaid suspension effective October 15, 2018, to December 14, 2018, was appropriate and is SUSTAINED.
