8. DEMAND FOR REINSTATEMENT

a) Consideration of the Demand for Reinstatement regarding the Discharge of **JESUS V. GARCIA** from his position as an Airport Superintendent of Operations III with the Department of Airports, effective October 17, 2023.

In his filing of July 7, 2026, Mr. Garcia failed to include any reasons supporting his Demand for Reinstatement. Staff recommends that the Board DENY the Demand for Reinstatement and make its timely filing within the 90-day period prescribed by Charter Section 1017 a matter of record.

9. **APPEAL UNDER CHARTER SECTION 1016**

a) Brenda RODRIGUEZ, Traffic Officer II, Transportation Department

Report and recommendations of the Board's Hearing Examiner Mary L. Williams, Esq., following the holding of hearings on November 4, 2025; December 2, 2025; February 11, 2026; March 19, 2026; and April 1, 2026 into the appeal of Ms. Rodriguez.

Pursuant to Government Code 54957, the Civil Service Commission may elect to meet in closed session in order to confer with its legal counsel regarding a matter related to pending litigation or the discipline of an employee under Charter Section 1016. No binding votes will be taken.

The Hearing Examiner recommends that the Board:

A. FIND that the City met its *Skelly* due process obligations.

B. Causes of Action:

1. NOT SUSTAIN the cause of action of Misconduct, on or off the job, unfavorably or seriously reflecting on the City or its employees, in that on July 4, 2020, Brenda Rodriguez failed to respond to a call regarding an illegally parked vehicle in the Baldwin Village area, resulting in a complaint being made to the Department by the reporting constituent for lack of service. Additionally, on that same date Brenda Rodriguez issued two inaccurate citations which were contested by constituents, and dismissed on the basis of "officer error." First offense.
2. SUSTAIN the cause of action of Violation of Department rules, in that on July 4 2020 Brenda Rodriguez violated multiple Department rules, including: Traffic Officer Manual 5/100; Daily Field Activity Reports, by: Failing to submit a true and complete Daily Field Activity Report; Handheld/Handwritten Duty Status Directive by failing to adequately report her duty status; Special Order #124: Hourly Check-in of Off-Shift Personnel, by failing to properly report check-in in that she failed to perform the duties of a Traffic Officer with honesty and integrity. First offense.
3. SUSTAIN the cause of action of Falsifying work-oriented documents, in that on July 4, 2020, Brenda Rodriguez falsified information on the Daily Field Activity Report for that day. First offense.
4. SUSTAIN the cause of action of Deliberately withholding information related to work from those requiring the information, in that on April 28, 2021, Brenda Rodriguez refused to answer questions during an interview with the Department's Professional Standards Group regarding her performance of job duties on July 4, 2020. First offense.

C. FIND that the penalty of Discharge effective June 6, 2025, was appropriate and should be SUSTAINED.

D. ADOPT the findings and conclusions in the Hearing Examiner's report as the Board's own.
