## LAST DAY TO FILE NOMINATING PETITIONS

### 2022 PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION

LOS ANGELES (**March 4, 2022**) — Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott reminds all candidates for the 2022 Primary Nominating Election that the deadline to file their nominating petition, and a supplemental petition, if required, is Wednesday, March 9, 2022, at 5:00 p.m.

In order to appear on the June 7, 2022 ballot, candidates for Los Angeles City Mayor, City Attorney, City Controller, Council Districts 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, and 15, and Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) Board of Education Districts 2, 4, and 6 must file a nominating petition. When filing a nominating petition, each candidate must choose to either: a) pay a filing fee of \$300 and submit at least 500 valid signatures from registered voters within their applicable jurisdiction, or b) waive the filing fee and submit at least 1,000 valid signatures from registered voters within their applicable jurisdiction.

Candidates who initially do not meet the required number of qualified voters' signatures may file supplemental petitions. However, all supplemental petitions must be filed by the same deadline as nominating petitions, which is Wednesday, March 9, 2022, at 5:00 p.m.

As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, nominating petition filing will be available by appointment. Candidates can schedule their appointments and obtain additional information by calling the Election Division or by visiting our website and selecting the "Municipal Election" section on the City Clerk's website at: [clerk.lacity.org/election](https://clerk.lacity.org/election).
