 - f. That The City of Los Angeles should create An Easy way for Citizens to Require Police to Enforce Regulation Requiring Signage at corners of streets where there is a sidewalk closure, when pedestrians are wrongfully forced to backtrack by paid corporate goons.
 - g. That The City of Los Angeles Establish A law which requires people Playing Stereos Loudly to Close All Their Windows and Doors While

Doing So, and that The City of Los Angeles Recognize Noise Disturbance as an Environmental Violation.

 - l. That The Environment Committee Address the environmental and Wildlife Displacement Issues of the Banana Bungalows project.
 - m. Study of Issues Regarding Resolution of some of the Runyon Canyon Environmental Issues Related to Dog Poo.
