Recommendation

Executive Summary

The development of the FY 2006-07 Proposed Emergency Operations Fund (EOF) budget involved the review of \$825,439 in requests from eleven City departments. The Emergency Management Committee (EMC) and its subcommittees reviewed each request and proposed a FY 2006-07 EOF Budget of \$528,840.

Subsequent to this approval, the FY 2006-07 EOF was reduced in the Mayor's Budget to \$183,100. Attached for your approval, as recommended by the EMC, is a revised FY 2006-07 EOF spending plan.

If approved, the budget will be forwarded to all appropriate City departments.

Executive Summary

In June 2005, staff began development of a City of Los Angeles Health Emergency Response Plan to ensure that the City is prepared to respond appropriately to any type of public health emergency including pandemic flu, bio-terrorist attack utilizing aerosolized anthrax, or health emergency resulting from a major natural or human-caused disaster. A Working Group including representatives from Emergency Operations Organization, various divisions of the Los Angeles County Department of Health Services, the Red Cross, US Department of Health and Human Services, US Department of Homeland Security, and other governmental, private and non-profit stakeholders oversaw preparation of the plan.

After review by all Working Group participants, the Emergency Management Committee approved the plan in June 2006.

If approved, the City of Los Angeles Health Emergency Response Plan will be forwarded to the Mayor for approval and transmittal to the City Council.

**Recommendation**

Transmit Draft Public Health Emergency Response Plan to the Emergency Operations Board with recommendation to approve and forward to the Mayor and City Council for adoption.

**Background**

In June, 2005 staff began development of a Health Emergency Response Plan to ensure that the City is prepared to respond appropriately to any type of public health emergency including pandemic flu, bio-terrorist attack utilizing aerosolized anthrax, or health emergency resulting from a major natural or human-caused disaster. Preparation of the plan was overseen by a Working Group including representatives from EOO and other City Departments, various divisions of the Los Angeles County Department of Health Services, the Red Cross, US Department of Health and Human Services, US Department of Homeland Security, and other governmental, private and non-profit stakeholders.

A working draft of the plan was completed in April and distributed to all Working Group participants and EMC members for review and comment. Numerous comments were received and have been incorporated into a revised draft ("Version 3") which was distributed for final review on May 15<sup>th</sup>. Substantive comments received as a result of the final review are being incorporated into the document.

The Plan will be presented to the EOB at the July meeting for approval and submittal to the Mayor and City Council.
