AGENDA

1. Public comments on matters within the Board's jurisdiction. A maximum of ten minutes will be provided for members of the public to address the Board on items of interest that are within the jurisdiction of the Board. Said ten minutes shall be equally divided among speakers, not to exceed five minutes per speaker.
2. Consideration of minutes of the Board meeting of May 23, 2022.
3. Executive Director's report:
 - a) New unfair employee relations practice claims filed.
 - b) Status of impasses.
 - c) Administrative matters, if any.
4. Consideration of requests to withdraw various matters, if any.

This meeting is being held pursuant to AB 361 Section 3(e)(3). Any or all Board Members may attend and participate by Teleconference/Virtual Meeting. Members of the public may participate by teleconference.



5. Determination, in accordance with AB 361 Section 3(e)(3), whether to make findings to continue teleconference meetings while the state of emergency due to COVID-19 pandemic, as originally proclaimed by the Governor on March 4, 2020, remains active and/or state or local officials have imposed or recommend measures to promote social distancing, and determination whether such findings support holding Board meetings via teleconference while the state of emergency continues to directly impact the ability of the members to meet safely in person and/or state or local officials continue to impose or recommend measures to promote social distancing.
6. Update on discussions between interested parties on the process for amending the Employee Relations Ordinance.
7. Recommending appropriate action on Petitions:
 - a) Petition C964, filed by American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees Local 3090 (AFSCME 3090), seeking accretion of the classes of Customer Information Representative Trainee (class code 1478), Customer Information Representative Assistant (class code 1479), Accounting Clerk Trainee (class code 1478), and Accounting Clerk Assistant (class code 1479), to the Clerical Unit (MOU 3).
 - b) Petition C965, filed by Engineers and Architects Association (EAA), seeking accretion of the class of Airport Planner (class code 7930) to the Supervisory Technical Unit (MOU 19).
8. Consideration of Draft Decision and Order in the matters of UERPs 1923-1928, filed by the Coalition of L.A. City Unions against the City of Los Angeles, alleging a failure to meet and confer over the elimination of reciprocity concerning “pension benefits” for employees transferring from LACERS to WPERP or vice versa.
